

# **Housing and Meal Options**

## **Housing**

Since we are holding the Conference at a Community College no housing is offered and the Area has not reserved blocks of rooms at any specific hotel for attendees of the conference. You are free to choose where you want to stay and how much you want to pay.

In Everett and Marysville (north of the Snohomish River about 3.5 miles from Everett CC) there are many lodging choices ranging in price from \$80/night-double room to \$200+/night-double room. Go to Trivago.com and search in Everett or Marysville for the best deals out there on the accommodation of your choice—hotels, B&Bs, Vacation Rental Homes.

## **Meals**

The facilities that we are using for the Conference are not set up so as to allow group meals. All meals will be on your own. The schedule allows ample time to travel to local restaurants, sandwich shops or markets for lunch and dinner. We will also try to have some food trucks at the Walt Price Fitness Center for lunch on Saturday and Sunday. We encourage everyone to meet new friends and plan your meals out together.
