DIRECTOR NOTES ... Your group will need to know <u>more</u> than what is printed in the music, so share the Director Notes with all ringers, and have them mark any changes in their music. Then, <u>practice</u> what is marked! Prepared ringers will have a much better festival experience, and so will LeAnna! Thank you!


CANCELLATION/REFUND Policy

All cancellation requests must be in writing (email is acceptable). Refunds in full will be made for cancellation requests received by the registration date. Refund requests made after the registration date AND prior to the festival opening will be processed as follows: (1) Refund request must be made in writing from the choir director; (2) Full Registration Fee will be refunded to the individual (or to the organization, if the registration was paid by organization); (3) Lunch will only be refunded up until the time the lunch order is placed with the caterer. After order is placed, there will be no refund of lunch; (4) Director Seminar fee will be refunded up until the start of the seminar, upon written request.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

SEMINAR LOCATION: First Presbyterian Church, 325 Elm St., Idaho Falls, ID FESTIVAL LOCATION: 2801 E. Sunnyside Rd., Ammon, ID



DRIVING TO THE SEMINAR from I-15: Driving south on I-15, take Exit 118. Turn left on W. Broadway. After 4 blocks, cross the Snake River. After another 4 blocks, stay to the left (the inside lane.) Notice Denning's Appliance, on the right. Continue on W. Broadway, crossing the railroad tracks. (Broadway becomes Elm St.) On the left, you pass the Museum of Idaho and the Trinity United Methodist Church. Drive one more block. First Presbyterian Church is on the left. Drive past the church, and turn into the parking lot.

DRIVING FROM THE SEMINAR to Hillcrest H.S. is a 13 min drive. of 4.7 miles.

From the church parking lot, turn left on Elm St. Enter the traffic circle and take the first right which is S Blvd. After 10 blocks, Hawthorne Elementary School is on the right side. Drive by the school and move to the inside lane before you reach 17th St. Drive straight through the intersection at 17th St, and continue on. Pass through the intersection at E. 25th St. Eventually, you will come to W. Sunnyside Rd. Turn left on Sunnyside Rd for the final 3 miles to Hillcrest H.S. The last major cross-street is S. 25th E. Drive through the intersection. Broulim's Fresh Foods on the right, and Eagle Drive is on the left. Turn left on Eagle Drive. At Derrald Ave, turn right and head for the Hillcrest H.S. parking lot and gym entrance.

HOTELS

There are 3 hotels in Ammon, ID that are a 5-minute drive from the festival site. There are many others further away in Idaho Falls, near I-15. If you prefer to stay closer to the festival site in Ammon, those three hotels are listed below. They each have a block of rooms set aside for us for April 25-26. They are all double-queen rooms @ \$139 + taxes.
