YOUR CLINICIAN: Kathryn Jurado

A musician with over 30 years of performance experience, 20 years of non-profit volunteer work, and lifelong church music ministry service, Kathryn Jurado has quickly gained prominence in the handbell community as a ringer and director. She is starting her first year as the Director of Handbell Activities at Landon School in Bethesda, Maryland, where she will lead students from grades 5 through 12. Kathryn also serves as President-Elect on the national board of Handbell Musicians of America, and is the Handbell and Instrumental Editor of Alfred Handbell, a division of Jubilate Music Group.



Born in Puerto Rico, Kathryn holds both a Bachelor and Master of Music degree from the University of South Florida in Tampa. Besides working as a freelance oboist, Kathryn has led a number of handbell ensembles that include groups at University of South Florida and Lake Magdelene Church (formerly UMC) in Tampa, the Magic of Bronze, an Orlando-based community handbell ensemble, and the Suncoast Bronze Ringers, a community handbell ensemble in the Tampa Bay area. She has been the clinician for a number of national events, including Reaching for Bronze (now known as Crescendo), the 2025 College Ring-in, and the 2025 Utah Spring Ring. In her spare time, Kathryn, along with her husband, William J. Murphy, enjoys traveling to Disney, cruising the Caribbean, and watching movies with their clowder of cats.

All lunches include fruit, chips, soda or bubbly water and a side of quinoa salad.

Open it on your computer to enter your information. Save the completed form, using the choir's name. (Suggested format: 2026 Festival Registration, Joyful Ringers.) Placement on the ringing floor is determined by the email date or the postmark date of a mailed form.

CANCELLATION/REFUND Policy

All cancellation requests must be in writing (email is acceptable). Refunds in full will be made for cancellation requests received by the registration due date. Refund requests made after the registration due date AND prior to the festival opening will be processed as follows: (1) Refund request must be made in writing from the choir director; (2) Full Registration Fee will be refunded to the individual (or to the organization, if the registration was paid by organization); (3) Lunch will only be refunded up until the time the lunch order is placed with the caterer. After order is placed, there will be no refund of lunch; (4) Director Seminar fee will be refunded up until the start of the seminar, upon written request.
